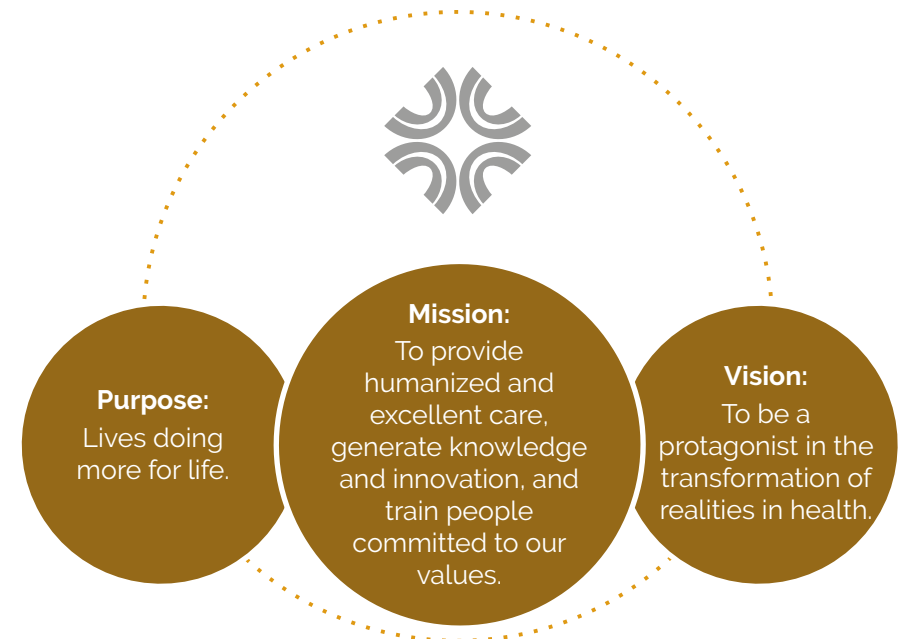


HOSPITAL DE CLÍNICAS DE PORTO ALEGRE (HCPA)

CARE Reference for high complexity care

- Multi-professional teams provide comprehensive and humanized care in medical, surgical, pediatric, obstetric, and psychiatric clinics.
- The modalities offered include: emergency care, consultations and outpatient procedures, surgeries, hospitalizations, deliveries, exams, and transplants.
- Most services are provided to SUS (Unified Health System) users. A small portion of services is intended for private and health insurance patients.
