- Most services are provided to SUS (Unified Health System) users. A small portion of services is intended for private and health insurance patients.

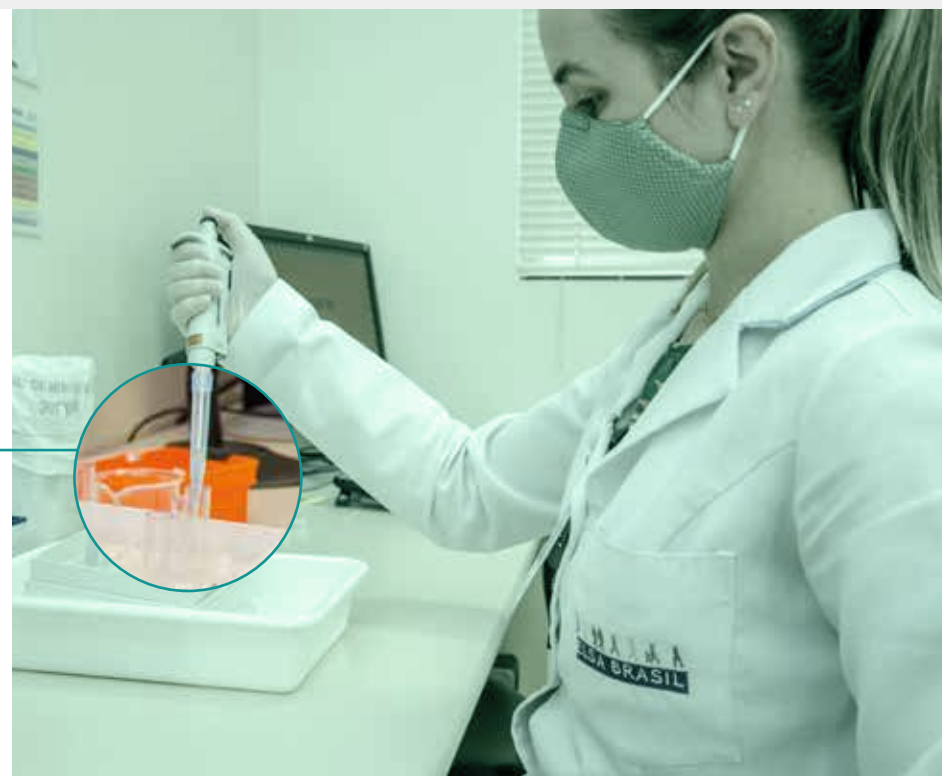
